

3. The owner/occupier shall allow the authorised officer access to the property at all reasonable times for inspection of the backflow device to ascertain and determine its satisfactory operation.
4. In cases of interconnected service, an approved backflow device shall be installed on the outlet side of the flow control fitting at or near the property boundary.
5. Whenever the authorised officer determines that the backflow device does not meet hazard requirements, the owner/occupier shall remove such backflow device and install an approved device. Alternatively the backflow device shall be removed by the owner/occupier and the water service altered to conform accordingly. In the event of the owner/occupier failing to do so, the Corporation may disconnect the water supply until the hazard is removed to prevent the possible contamination of the Corporation's asset.
6. The owner/occupier shall give at least thirty (30) days notice in writing to the Corporation prior to terminating the occupancy of the property on which the backflow preventer is installed.
7. The Agreement shall be for a period of twelve (12) months commencing on the approval date and at the expiration of the twelve month period may be renewed, and may automatically continue for succeeding periods of twelve (12) months until terminated or varied after one month's notice by either party.

The Agreement is not transferable and will expire should the applicant cease to occupy the property referred to in this Agreement.
